

# Sausage Sizzle 101

**Do you want to get your Smiddy fundraising sizzling? It can be as simple as throwing a snag on the BBQ!**

Your first step to holding your sausage sizzle fundraiser should be to **get in touch with your local Bunnings or shopping centre**. They run sausage sizzles regularly so have a great idea on the exact number of customers you'll get, the supplies you'll need and most importantly, what dates are free!

Even better, they can help take some of the legwork out by providing supplies like BBQs or marquees. The earlier you get in touch the better, as the success of these fundraisers means a popular Bunnings or Coles sausage sizzle spot can book out months in advance!

Your local shopping centre or Bunnings contact will be able to let you know what quantities you'll need, but here's a quick rundown of essential supplies to make your sausage sizzle a success!



## Supplies

- BBQ unit, including gas
- Marquee
- Sand bags (for marquee)
- Blackboard (for prices)
- Ground mat
- Smiddy posters (get them [here](#))
- Cash float (at least \$100 with lots of coins)
- Fire extinguisher and fire blanket
- Eskies and ice
- Trestle table x 2 (1 small and 1 large table)
- Tablecloths x 2
- Sausages, bread, onions, tomato sauce, BBQ sauce and American Mustard sauce
- Cans of drink, bottled water
- Napkins, garbage bags
- Aprons, disposable gloves, paper towel
- Cooking utensils (tongs, spatula, knives)
- Cleaning equipment and hand sanitiser
- Fresh water filled container
- Tin spray of cooking oil
- Appropriate food grade storage containers
- CURRENT PUBLIC LIABILITY CERTIFICATE

## Try get your supplies donated
