Compulsory Pre-Ride Bike Inspection Certificate

As a participant of a Smiling for Smiddy Challenge, you must ensure that the bicycle you will be using for the event has been fully serviced and is in excellent working order

Every bike must be in perfect working order as one faulty bike can affect everyone.

1. Bottom Bracket (bearings checked, tightened and lubricated)
2. Bottle Cages - minimum of 2
3. Brakes - both fully functional, tight, centered & brake pads in excellent order
4. Handlebars - aligned, tightened by torque wrench and bar plugs fitted
5. Headset - check tightness with torque wrench and lubricate
6. Seat & seat post - Tighten with torque wrench (mark seat height before removing post)
7. Pedals & Cleats - Tighten cleats (We recommend new cleats & cleat cover)
8. Cables (gear & brake) -In excellent order & no sign of rust or corrosion
9. New tyres must be installed prior to ride (2 tubes and tyre levers must be carried)
10. Wheels must be true and spokes tightened (**Spare spokes and nipples must be carried F&R**)
11. Wheel hubs checked, lubricated and in excellent working order (Cassette tightened)
12. Derailleurs & Gears must be adjusted and working properly (Bring Di2 charger)
13. Rear derailleur hanger must be purchased (each frame has its own unique hanger)
14. Rear cassette, chain & chain rings –Must be in excellent condition (Replace if worn)
15. Bike has disc brakes (Install calliper wedges when transporting) YES NO
